If you are interested in earning internship credit, we recommend you discuss this with your academic advisor.

Our expectations

Previous travel experience or group leadership is not a prerequisite, but advantageous. We expect interns to be motivated, and to display maturity and sensitivity in their interactions with other participants, and cultures. Whilst not in an outright leadership role, you will be seen as something of a mentor by others on the program.

What you can expect

Your program leader will put effort and time into facilitating the development of your leadership skills. You can expect to learn about and gain experience in:

- Program planning
- Logistics
- Communication skills
- Cultural interactions
- Group facilitation
- Conflict resolution
- Participant mentoring

We have a mid-trip and final evaluation to ensure both your and the leader's expectations are being met. At the conclusion of the program, the program leader, in conjunction with Pacific Discovery will forward to you, a letter of reference.
